



2012 SPRING GRADUATING STUDENT SURVEY SUMMARY REPORT

Highlights

- 162 graduates responded to the survey. The total number of degrees and certificates conferred in Spring 2012 was 432. Response rate for survey is approximately 37.5%.
- 70.4% of responding graduates were female. 75.3% of respondents were enrolled full-time, 24.1% were enrolled part-time while attending Dalton State.
- 7.4% of students worked on campus while attending Dalton State; 41.9% worked off-campus while attending Dalton State, 22.2% worked 36 or more hours per week.
- 71.6% of respondents reported that their objective for attending Dalton State was fully accomplished.
- A majority (25.3%) completed their degree or certificated program in four years.
- 33.3% of respondents said their immediate plans after graduation was to obtain further education.
- 22.8% of respondents indicated that they were “extremely well” prepared for continuing their education.
- 51.2% of respondents who entered the labor force said that their new job was “directly related” to their program of study.
- 86.4% of respondents rated the quality of education they received at Dalton State as “Excellent” or “Good.”
- 89.5% of respondents indicated that their overall impression/attitude of Dalton State was “Positive” or “Very Positive.”
- 78.4% of respondents indicated that they would recommend Dalton State to someone who wanted to major in their program.
- 40.1% indicated that if they could start college over, they would “definitely” choose to attend Dalton State.
- 93.2% of respondents rated their level of satisfaction with the education they received at Dalton State as “Satisfied” or “Very Satisfied.”
