7 AS INTRODUCED

8 A Dalton State Student Governance Bill to

9 A bill reducing the number of voting faculty and staff representatives within the student governance
10 association to become effective for the 2022 elections.

11 **WHEREAS,** Student Government is for the students, by the students, and will always serve students

12 **WHEREAS,** Faculty Representatives serve to provide context to the students on faculty perspective and
13 advocate on behalf of faculty, and,

14 **WHEREAS,** Staff Representatives serve to provide context to the students on staff perspective and advocate
15 on behalf of staff.

16 **RESOLVED,** The Student Government Association reduce the number votes of faculty and staff voting
17 members to zero, and

18 **RESOLVED,** that each faculty and staff representative will continue to serve a two-year term, and

19 **RESOLVED,** that each faculty and staff representative be elected on a staggered occurrence to aid in
20 providing continuity and context throughout each transition.

21 **THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE DALTON STATE COLLEGE STUDENT GOVERNANCE ASSOCIATION THAT**

22 **ACTION 1:** The Constitution of the Student Government Association of Dalton State College amend Article
23 III. II. IV to read "Faculty Representatives" The faculty representatives shall consist of two faculty
24 representatives elected to serve a two-year term on the SGA as non-voting members."

25 **ACTION 2:** The Constitution of the Student Government Association of Dalton State College amend Article
26 III. II. V to read "Staff Representatives" The staff representative shall consist of two staff representatives
27 elected to serve a two-year term on the SGA as non-voting members."

28 **RESOLVED:** This legislation shall take effect for the 2022 elections upon a two-thirds majority vote by the
29 Student Government Association Senate.
