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## 2000-2001 GRADUATING STUDENT SURVEY RESULTS

### SUMMARY REPORT

#### *Highlights*

- 185 or 63% of graduates responded to survey. The total number of degrees and certificates conferred in 2000-2001 was 295.
- 71% of responding graduates were female. 61% of respondents enrolled full-time while attending Dalton State College.
- 86% of students worked while attending Dalton State College; 30% worked 36 or more hours per week.
- 77% reported that their objective for attending Dalton State College was fully accomplished.
- A slight majority (35%) completed their degree or certificate program in three years.
- 61% said their immediate plans after graduation was to obtain further education.
- 33% indicated that they were “extremely well” prepared for continuing their education.
- 44% of respondents who entered the labor force said that their new job was related to their program of study.
- 50% rated the quality of education they received at Dalton State College as “Excellent.”
- 84% of respondents indicated they would recommend Dalton State College to someone who wanted to major in their program.
- 54% said if they could start college over, they would “definitely” choose to attend Dalton State College.
- Overall, 55% rated their level of satisfaction with the education they received at Dalton State College as “Very Satisfied.”
