The milestones listed below each year are designed to keep you on course to graduate in four years. Missing milestones could prevent you from being eligible for a particular program or could result in a delay in graduation. The Program Pathway serves as a general guideline to help you build a full schedule each term.

- If planning to enter the job market after graduation, update your resume, practice mock interviews, and attend the Career Fair.
