The requirements for admissions to the REPP program are:

- 1. A combined SAT score of at least 1090 (including a minimum of 560 on the math and 440 on the verbal portion) or a composite ACT score of 24 (including 25 on the math and 18 on the verbal portion) and
- 2. A high school GPA of at least 3.0 and
- 3. Be enrolled at Dalton State College and
- 4. Complete any Learning Support and/or CPC requirements

Students who do not meet the initial admission criteria may qualify for the REPP by:

- 1. Completing Chemistry I, Physics I, and Calculus I and II with a grade of B or higher in each course and
- 2. Completing Calculus II, Physics I, and Chemistry I within 3 semesters of completing Calculus I and
- 3. Attaining a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher

The REP is an agreement with the REP Engineering Institutions within the USG. This agreement is intended for students entering DSC directly from high school. A student who has attended other colleges and is transferring to DSC may apply for acceptance into the REP. The REP Coordinator and Advisory Board will consider these applications on a case by case basis.
