This map is a term-by-term sample course schedule and is a general recommendation. DSC encourages all students to take between 30-33 hours per year to graduate in two years. Learning support requirements may impact schedule. ENGL 1101, 1102, MATH 1101/1111 are foundation courses. Bold courses have been identified as "key courses." It is required that students pass these key courses with a "C" or higher in order to be successful in this program. Taking courses in sequence is critical to prevent delay.
