**Donors may designate scholarships** for any school (Arts & Sciences, Education, Health Professions, or Wright School of Business) or academic major, student research or leadership, athletics, a particular geographic region, or all students.

**Removing financial barriers to attend college** is our highest priority, and we encourage donors to include financial need in their scholarship selection criteria.

## Timeline of activity:

- October-January: Students apply for scholarships
- **December 31:** Non-endowed scholarship funds due to Foundation
- January: 4% spend budgets for endowed scholarships are set
- **February:** Faculty evaluate qualified applications and match to available awards
- March: Donors & students are invited to attend Scholarship Day
- Late April: Scholarships presented at Scholarship Day
- May: Foundation sends donors thank-you notes and photos from Scholarship Day
