Tuition & fees are found at www.daltonstate.edu > Admissions > Tuition & Fees. For the 2024-2025 academic year, tuition & fees for in-state students attending full-time are \$1,995.

Donors may designate scholarships for any school (Arts & Sciences, Education, Health Professions, or Wright School of Business) or academic major, student research or leadership, athletics, a particular geographic region, or all students.

Removing financial barriers to attend college is our highest priority, and we encourage donors to include financial need in their scholarship selection criteria.

Timeline of activity:

- **October-January:** Students apply for scholarships
- **December 31:** Non-endowed scholarship funds due to Foundation
- **January:** 4% spend budgets for endowed scholarships are set
- **February:** Faculty evaluate qualified applications and match to available awards
- **March:** Donors & students are invited to attend Scholarship Day
- **Late April:** Scholarships presented at Scholarship Day
- **May:** Foundation sends donors thank-you notes and photos from Scholarship Day
